Open AutoCAD or Revit

Open a job or project

Click on the Trimble Field Points tab



On the far-right side of the ribbon, locate, but do not click "Settings"

Click under it on "Setup" drop down arrow



Under "Setup" you will see "License Manager"

If an error pops up, click OK

Click OK on all the error messages.

To test if it works, try placing a manual point in Trimble Field Points

If the Place Point dialogue box pops up, you licensed.
